Top 10 Safety Tips

Some safety tips for your display:

- Always read the instructions on each firework as all differ. Never use a naked flame to read the instructions and always use a torch light
- All fireworks should be stored safely in a closed box and must be kept in a cool and dry area out of the reach of children and animals
- Never smoke or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs when handling fireworks
- Keep all pets locked indoor when lighting fireworks
- Never keep fireworks in bags or pockets
- Always use protective gloves and goggles when firing fireworks

- Never return to a lit firework
 - Always light fireworks at arm's length using a portfire or fuse wick
 - Never put any fireworks onto a bonfire, whether they have been used or are unused
 - Always abide by the safety firing distances

Fireworks Law

It is illegal to:

- Possess professional display fireworks unless you have a professional licence
- Set off fireworks between 11pm and 7am, except on the following extended days
 - Bonfire Night, from 12am to the following day
 - Chinese New Year, from 1am to the following day
 - Diwali, from 1am to the following day
 - New Years Eve, from 1am to the following day
